



Student Suspensions in Special Education

Do you know your rights?

WORKSHOP DETAILS:

Students with disabilities are suspended at a disproportionately higher rate than their non-disabled peers. Recent NYS data shows that for all students with disabilities, 1 in 10 will face at least one suspension over the course of their education. **Do you know what steps to take if your child is faced with the possibility of suspension?**

At this workshop, participants will learn:

- Regulations surrounding short term and long term suspension
- Parent rights to request a conference, receive a fair trial, and review the suspension decision
- NYS laws and policies that protect your child's access to education and services in the event of suspension
- Your child's rights if an incident was caused by a manifestation of their disability or result of an IEP not being implemented
